

- 2. Organizations demonstrating a commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion and accessibility through their programming, staffing and operations
- 3. 501(c)(3) non-profit
- 4. Individuals or groups supporting community-led initiatives without nonprofit status
- 5. Firm certified by the Oregon Certification Office of Business Inclusion and Diversity (COBID)

## Requirements

- 1. Events must occur between April 1, 2025, and June 30, 2026
- 2. Events contracted within the past 5 years are ineligible
  - o March 3, 2025, and before
- 3. No funding for expenses outside OCC services
- 4. General liability insurance \$2M
  - Estimated cost: \$200
- 5. Post-event reporting on impact






